



## 2020 Australian Hay Mini Nationals

2020 Australian Hay Mini Nationals organisers statement.

With the threat of COVID 19 (Coronavirus) causing cancellations of major events the world over, organisers of the Hay Mini Nationals have sought and been working with information from Motorsport Australia, and the Shire Council of Hay to formulate a plan for this year's event. Organisers have made the decision with the current and forecast information on hand, that the 2020 Australian Hay Mini Nationals will go ahead as planned with some modification and requirements.

- **Currently, there is no Covid 19 virus in Hay**
- **It is our intent to ensure the Covid 19 virus does not get to Hay via our participants.**
- Any person who has returned from ANY overseas travel in the 14 days prior to the Mini Nationals is asked to remain in self-isolation and NOT TO ATTEND (14 days before is the 22<sup>nd</sup> May)
- Any Person who is displaying ANY cold or flu symptoms in the lead up to the event is asked NOT TO ATTEND.
- Should any person start displaying these symptoms during the event they are asked to immediately report that fact to the organisers and to self-isolate.
- Any person who has had any unprotected contact with any known or suspected Covid 19 case in the 14 days before the event is asked NOT TO ATTEND
- Depending on the development and spread of the virus in the next few months we may need to cancel, modify or postpone the reunion party (Friday night) and the presentation party (Sunday night)
- All participants will have access to, and be strongly encouraged to use hand sanitiser throughout the event. (supplied)
- All participants will be encouraged to maintain where possible a 1.5 metre separation between each other and avoid contact.
- Any coughs or sneezes should be caught with a tissue or an inner elbow to prevent spread of airborne molecules.

As usual the event will have a designated first aider. However this year there will be a separate area designated at each venue where they may assess someone if they are suspected of having the virus. Should a participant need further assessment, they will be transported to the Hay hospital for further tests and isolation if necessary.

This is an evolving situation. If further changes need to be made, we will notify you as soon as possible.
